Open call for thematic panels

The official languages are Italian, English and Spanish.

The Scientific Committee of the 4<sup>th</sup> Symposium announces the opening of the call for the presentation of thematic panels, which may address any of the themes proposed in the guidelines, with one or two coordinators in charge. The papers selected through the open call will be presented as part of the round tables designed by the coordinators.

The proposals cannot be longer than 400 words, must be presented in English or in any of the other languages of the symposium with the following format:

- Title of the proposed thematic panel. Institutional affiliation of the coordinator(s).
- General description of the topic to be addressed and the specific objective of the panel.
- Justification of the relevance of the thematic panel for the Diaspore Italiane network.
- Summary of the type of papers to be presented (e.g., studies in progress, completed research, theoretical or empirical profile).

The Scientific Committee will evaluate the proposals and will announce the list of selected thematic panels on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021. The Scientific Committee may suggest the combination of similar thematic panels in the case of identical areas of specialization.

Each panel is scheduled to last 75 minutes, divided into 15 minutes of general presentation by the coordinator(s), 15 minutes per speaker and 15 minutes of discussion at the end of the presentations.

Once the list of approved panels has been published, a second circular will be sent out to request the submission of proposals for papers. The panel coordinator(s) will be in charge of the evaluation of the presentations and will send a list of the selected papers to the organizing committee. Abstracts may be up to 200 words in length and should be sent to the e-mail address indicated by the coordinators when submitting the thematic panel.
